In this workshop you will explore collage and stencils.

This mixed media class is suitable for beginners and experienced artists.

WHAT TO BRING :

2-3 pieces of 300gsm A3 water colour paper

Paint brushes, Acrylic paint, a pencil for sketching and a rubber.

Old books and scrap booking papers to tear up. Brown paper or a few pieces of plain paper of any colour.

Ribbon or washi tape (a coloured sticky tape) and a glue stick.
Stick of charcoal

Old buttons, glue gun, stamps or stamp pad and fruit pictures (optional)

Jo will supply stencils and tea to age the paper.

It's good to think up a colour scheme in advance and then bring things that match this specific colour palette. I went with yellow and green and beige. So my ribbons and buttons and washi tape and plain and coloured papers all matched this scheme.
