Cyanotype is an alternative photography technique which uses the sun for exposure. As an enlarger is not used, like in traditional photography, you can use real objects (like feathers, leaves, glass ornaments, or anything that casts a shadow) or full-size negatives to create a print. The prints can be quite unique depending on the strength of the sun, where it was exposed, and how long it was exposed for. The cyanotype emulsion can be applied to paper or fabric. They can be toned with different teas and other tannin-rich products after exposure. On the day, we will learn from start to finish from coating paper to exposing the cyanotype to finishing your cyanotype by toning.
